COMMUNICATIONS

Chief Vineyard stated that Andy Klein donated \$1,000.00 to the District's Honor Guard. Since the District fully funds its Honor Guard, the Honor Guard agreed that the District's Firefighters Community Outreach program could better benefit from this donation as they use funds to assist District citizens in need.

Shop Steward Johnston read a letter from O'Fallon Professional Firefighters, Local 2665 stating their intent to enter into negotiations with the District.

Administrative Assistant Lucido read the following correspondence:

OLD BUSINESS

There was further discussion regarding Station Renovations. Per Chief Vineyard: Station #5: There were issues with the shower size and a solution has been worked out with Layneco; the ADA shower is okay as is. Issues with Solar Panel conduit having to be moved - Layneco is working with Warren Electric to have this done. Station #1: Waiting on contract to be signed by Layneco and returned. Station #4: Weis dropped off preliminary drawings which will be reviewed.

There was further discussion regarding the Firefighter-EMT/P Hiring Process. Chief Vineyard stated the written test for applicants is set for October 31; there will be 87 applicants testing.

NEW BUSINESS

Rick Rognan gave the District's Financial Review through the month of September 2017. The District's tax collection is up; vehicle maintenance is over budget; anticipate District Reserves at \$3 million. The District has experienced 47 less fire calls than last year, but have responded to 99 more EMS calls, which is why the District is in the process of hiring 12 additional Firefighter EMT-P's. Projections are that the District will stay under budget for 2017, and is financially very healthy. Attorney Bruntrager commended Mr. Rognan on the services he provides for the District.

Director Laughlin announced that the District will hold an election for one Board of Director Seat, 6 year term, in the April 2018 Election. A motion was made by Director Laughlin to read Resolution 2017-09 by Title only, seconded by Director Simmons. Upon roll call the vote was:

Assistant Chief Moore stated that the District's health insurance is up for renewal and the current provider is quoting an initial 22% increase in premium. The District has gone out for underwriting to obtain a quote from Anthem. Chief Moore discussed the various options available to the District to help with bringing down premium costs.

Chief Vineyard stated Unicom-Arc is now publishing the District's newsletter. Previously the newsletter was sent to 8,000 residents, but he is recommending we try to reach 37,000 citizens to inform as many as our residents as possible on the ongoing events of the District. Chief Vineyard is working with other departments who also use Unicom-Arc to go in on printing costs to help bring the cost of the newsletter down.

Chief Vineyard stated that the American Legion is honoring Firefighter of the Year, Engineer Tom Vogelgesang, at a dinner to be held at Cornerstone Church, November 20, at 6:00pm.
